



## Coiste Chontae Aontroma Match Regulations for County Championships

- 1 A maximum of 3 team officials**, plus 1 club Officer, plus 1 medical attendant are permitted on the sidelines (**Total 5**)  
**Fine of £50 for non-compliance**

Additionally **2 Water carriers, (Football) and 3 Hurley / Water carriers (Hurling)** with bibs, may be stationed at designated points. (1 on the 22mtr line /1 on the 45 mtr line on opposite sides of the pitch) (**Total -2 football 3 Hurling**)  
Water Carriers are not permitted to enter field of play.  
**Fine of £50 for non-compliance**

The Bainisteoir may remain on the touch line and the Maor Foirne can approach the Bainisteoir for discussions but **must return** to the bench.  
**Fine of £50 for non-compliance**

Only the Maor Foirne can enter the field of play to issue instructions to players.  
**Fine of £50 for non-compliance**

Only the designated medical personnel are permitted to enter the playing Area to attend injured players  
The medical attendant may only enter the playing area with the permission of the referee  
**Fine of £50 for non-compliance**

### **Bids must be supplied by the club as follows;**

*Bainisteoir, Maor Foirne, Physio / Doctor, Maor Caman / Maor Uisce*

Substitutes will be located outside the playing area where feasible.

**2 (A)** For all Senior Championship games in Football and Hurling (and any other championship games as may be required) clubs shall forward their panel numbered 1-24 to the County P.R.O. by the Wednesday prior to the game(s), or as requested.

**Fine of £50 for non-compliance.**

**(B)** Players to play as numbered on the programme.

**Fine for non-compliance - £50.**

Games will be supervised and breaches of regulation will be reported to the County Management Committee who will consider and impose penalties, including fines. Fines imposed will be invoiced to the clubs by the County Treasurer and are to be paid within one (1) month of the invoice date.

**All fines imposed are in addition to penalties as imposed by An Treorai Oifigiuil.**

**3** Players and officials will be required to use passes, where supplied, to gain access to the ground and dressing rooms.

Teams shall take and leave the field in accordance with regulations as per Treorai Oifigiuil. I.e. *1<sup>st</sup> team out leaves the field 1<sup>st</sup> at halftime.*

**4** The video recording of games is subject to permission being granted by An Coiste Bainisti prior to the date of the game. Permission, from the County Secretary, is subject to the recording being handed over immediately upon request from a member of An Coiste Bainisti or other designated official.

**5** In Casement Park the entrance for players and officials will be at a designated point. Admission to the dressing rooms will be via the entrance at the rear of the stand. Access for cars will be by pass only.

**6** Extra time will be played in the following championships, up to and including semi-final stages: Minor, U21 Junior, Intermediate Football & Hurling and all reserve competitions.

Extra time will be played in all Championship / Reserve Final replays.

**7** Any replays will be played within four days following the drawn game or as directed by Competitions Control Committee.

**8** The financial penalty for failure to field in a championship game will be **£300**. This is in addition to penalties as imposed by An Treorai Oifigiuil.

**9** The relevant county sponsors must be afforded every facility in regard to displaying promotional and advertising material as necessary at any grounds used for championship fixtures.
